# FA Learning FA Youth Award Module 2—Developing the Practice

This is a 32 hour course aimed at those working with 12-16 year old players, delivered over four days to include a formative assessment.

## **Who should enrol?**

To enrol on the FA YOUTH AWARD MODULE 2 candidates must hold a minimum of 1st4Sport Level 2 Coaching Certificate in Football or FA YOUTH AWARD MODULE 1 and be 17 years of age or over.

## **Course details:**

Workshops will consider age and maturity issues, different types of practice and the advantages and disadvantages of each, unopposed and opposed practice development, dealing with talented players and issues in planning and evaluating. However, this is primarily a practical-based course. Different types of practices will be demonstrated and delivered and candidates will be expected to evaluate these practices as well as plan, deliver and evaluate their own practices. Candidates will be encouraged to take part and those not taking part will be expected to build on their evaluating and observational skills.

## **Elements include:**

- Values and beliefs.
- How players develop physically and mentally.
- Planning / delivering
- Practise according to age, maturity, ability, experience.
- Building a coach's toolbox.
- Moving from repetition to choice.
- On-course staff demonstrations.
- On-course student tasks

Three modules are being developed:

Module 1: Developing the Environment, focussing on the 5-11 age group

Module 2: Developing the Practice, focussing on 12-16 year old player

Module 3: Developing The Player, with emphasis on the 17-21 age group

With the new FA Youth Award promising to be one of the most popular FA courses yet, make sure you take your place and put yourself at the forefront of football coaching.

**Please note: the course will contain both practical and theory aspects and all 4 days must be attended in order to achieve the award.**
