The course cost for participants not attached to a FA Charter Standard Club is **£220.00**. **BURSARIES MAY BE AVAILABLE TO ASSIST WITH COURSE COSTS.**

**PLEASE NOTE** This course will only be registered with the F.A. and go ahead if there is a minimum of 18 completed applications including full course fees received by the application deadline. There will be no refunds given unless the course is cancelled by the H.F.A.

Candidates are expected to have completed the **FA Safeguarding Children In Football** workshop (formerly FA Child Protection & Best Practice) and the **FA Emergency Aid** workshop or equivalent either before the course of training or before the final assessment. The cost of these workshops is not included in the Level 2 course cost. Candidates are also expected to complete all necessary course tasks prior to the final assessment. The Herefordshire FA will not provide an alternative final assessment opportunity for candidates who do not attend on the agreed final assessment dates. A re-assessment opportunity for candidates will be organised for those who were unsuccessful.

**Course of Learning:**

Will be conducted by the Course Tutor (Coach Educator/Internal Assessor)

**Theory:**

This will be detailed in the course programme when your course place is confirmed.

**Practical:**

The practical sessions will cover:

- Technique Practices
- Skills practices
- Small sided games (4v4)

You will play in the sessions and also have the opportunity to coach your colleagues which will allow your Course Tutor to feedback to individuals and the group to enable you to identify strengths and weaknesses and then design personal action plans.

**FA Safeguarding Children in Football:**

**Distance Learning:**

You will be required to do the following homework:

Complete the course tasks and formulate your Candidate Pack for Assessment.

Conduct a minimum of 16 hours of verified coaching, supported by session plans and evaluations.

Work to your Action Plan as discussed with your Course Tutor.

After successfully completing the course, please remember to download the screen certificate or for a small fee purchase the certificate from FA Learning.

**Support Sessions:**

In between the course of learning and the final assessment you will need to attend support sessions which will focus on practical and theory issues in order to assist you in preparation for your final assessment.

**Final Assessment:**

You will need to submit your completed candidate pack for assessment three weeks prior to the assessment date. The Tutor will assess the pack (Independent Assessor).

You will receive your final assessment topics and you will then meet with the Assessor to discuss your pack and any questions you have regarding your topics.

**Practical:**

You will be required to attend two full days where you will need to plan and deliver:

- A technique session which will follow into a skill session
- A small sided game (4 v 4)

**Theory/Oral Interview:** Once all the coaching sessions have been completed, candidates will have personal interviews with the External Assessor who will inform you of the final decision and discuss your action plan to develop
