**COURSE OUTLINE**

The FA Coaching Disabled Footballers course is designed to give football coaches and teacher's ideas and practices for the inclusion of disabled players in football sessions within mainstream or impairment specific sessions. The course duration is 6 hours and covers both theory and practical elements. by the end of the workshop each participant should be able to meet the following outcomes:

- Apply and extend your existing coaching skills and experience, meeting the needs of players with a range of impairments.
- Establish basic communication skills for coaching disabled footballers.
- Use appropriate terminology
- Identify appropriate safety and medical considerations.
- Plan a wide range of coaching sessions for disabled footballers.
- Using the Inclusion Spectrum, plan your coaching sessions to include disabled players or provide alternative appropriate opportunities.
- Understand the player pathways available for disabled players including the appropriate structure for competition.

Places are limited for this course and will be allocated on a first come, first served basis upon receipt of completed application forms, course payment and a copy of your FA Level 1 Certificate in Coaching Football.
