

FUTSAL DEVELOPMENT ASPIRATIONS

Our overall aims / KEY THEMES in partnership with ELITE 6-a-sides are to:

- Raise awareness of Futsal – ONGOING
- In partnership with the new POINT4 facility host a England International Futsal fixture – BY END OF 2009
- In partnership with the new POINT4 facility host England International Futsal fixtures on a regular basis
- Produce a detailed 3 year Herefordshire Futsal development plan – BY END OF JUNE 2009
- Demonstrate that Futsal can help with the development of technically gifted and skilful players with benefits to mini-soccer and 11 v 11 - ONGOING
- Provide countywide facilities suitable for Futsal – ONGOING
- Provide HFA Technique and Skill Centres for 5 – 11 year olds focusing on 1 v 1 moves linked to Futsal in partnership with FA Charter Standard clubs – 3 CENTRES BY END OF 2010
- Have Futsal accepted as the preferred version of 5-a-side – BY END 2009
- Develop a sustainable Futsal coaching workforce - ONGOING
- Develop a sustainable Futsal referee workforce - ONGOING
- Develop sustainable primary and secondary school Futsal leagues as qualifiers in clusters for FA National Junior Futsal finals annually – ALL CLUSTERS BY END OF 2010
- Develop Futsal specific clubs/sections for junior players linked to school to club programme - 4 CLUBS BY END OF 2009
- Develop sustainable FA Charter Standard club junior male Futsal leagues at U10, U12, U14 and U16 age groups as qualifiers for the FA National Junior Futsal finals annually – BY END OF 2009
- Develop sustainable adult male Futsal leagues – BY END OF 2009
- Identify and develop an elite squad of adult players – BY END OF 2009
- Create an adult male Futsal club – BY END OF 2009
- Enter adult male Futsal club team into FA National Futsal league structure – BY END OF 2010
